## HMAS SYDNEY I – SMS EMDEN ENGAGEMENT 102nd ANNIVERSARY MEMORIAL SERVICE – Bradley's Head 11.00am Sunday 6 November 2016

On Sunday 6 November 2016 the HMAS SYDNEY Association Inc. will hold a Memorial Service to remember the 102nd Anniversary of the engagement and subsequent sinking of the German cruiser SMS EMDEN by HMAS SYDNEY I near the Cocos and Keeling Islands. The Memorial Service will take place at Bradley's Head Reserve commencing at 1100. Below I have detailed the transport options.

FERRY: The following ferries leaving Circular Quay (check information boards for departure wharf as this sometime changes) that will get you there on time, all will be met at the bus stop opposite the Zoo wharf by a "shuttle bus" that will take you the site.

BUSES: Plenty of them (244) from Stand A, Carrington Street (Wynyard Park) but unless you change at Mosman it is a kilometer "Stroll" to the Zoo. Recommend the ferry is the best bet.

CAR: Drive to and park in the Taronga Park Zoo car park. The "shuttle bus" will run from the RTA bus stop at the south end of the car park to the site. (you can "walk" down the hill). There will be National Park and Wildlife Service Rangers to direct you. DISABLED: There is no parking in the park itself but if you need to "drop off" then you will have to give me details of your motor vehicle make and rego. NPWS will let you
